Area of Focus

NEFE focuses on awarding grants to support innovative research projects that have actionable outcomes that are directly relevant to the financial well-being of the public and broadly applicable to a variety of U.S. households or individuals. We welcome all research concepts that align with our mission and are compatible with our eligibility requirements. Interdisciplinary research projects are of special interest.
